


Halloween at White House

Directions

From the M25 leave at junction 6 and head south on the A22 towards South Godstone, East Grinstead, Uckfield for approx. 20 miles. When you reach the Lampool Roundabout take the first exit onto the Straight Half Mile. At the next roundabout take the first exit onto High Street to Budletts Roundabout. Take the second exit onto London Road for about a third of a mile and look for SLC signs indicating the venue entrance on the right.

From Tunbridge Wells follow the A26 towards Crowborough and Uckfield. Travel approx. 13 miles through Eridge, Boarshead and Herons Ghyll to the Budletts Roundabout. Take the second exit onto London Road for about a third of a mile and look for SLC signs indicating the venue entrance on the right.
