

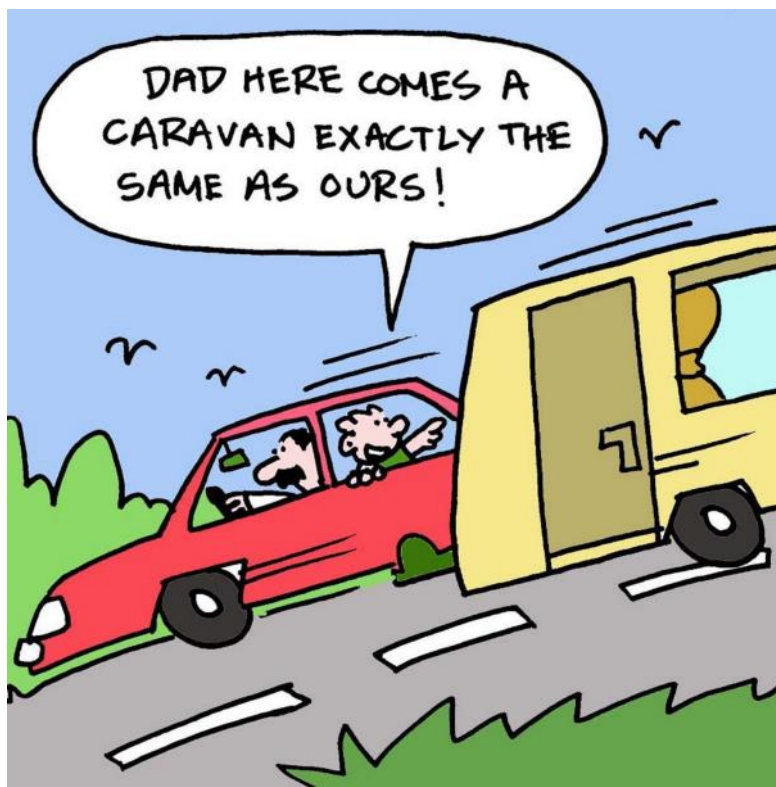

NOTES

Brief History of the South London Centre

The London Centre was formed on 17th October 1937 and was the first centre in 1938 to start the Christmas Social Rally which was at Wrotham Moat House, Kent. 25 vans booked in beforehand but due to a heavy snow fall, only 12 vans could actually attend. However, 75 members did attend the social on the Saturday evening.



In September 1945, the London Centre split into two Centres, the Northern Home Counties Centre and the South London Centre. So in 2025 the South London Centre celebrated its 80th Birthday.



The Northern Home Counties Centre split into 5 Centres in 1967: North London, Middlesex, Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire and Buckinghamshire Centres, reaching their 58th anniversaries in 2025.

WHY NOT TRY AN SLC EVENT

WHAT IS AN EVENT

A Rally/Event is a gathering of Caravan Club Members who enjoy weekends and longer breaks with friends and like minded people with whom we share a common interest.

THE EVENT MARSHAL

Is a friendly face who will meet & greet you on arrival at the venue. Your Event Marshal will explain where to site your caravan/motorhome and give guidance if necessary, where the facilities are located and any social activities that are going on during the rally.

WHAT TO DO

After you have booked in by submitting an Event Booking Form and the time arrives, follow the directions on the form. As you approach the venue look out for the SLC signs positioned strategically to direct you to the venue entrance. They are small arrows with the letters SLC in red on a white background. When you arrive look for the Event Marshal's caravan/motorhome normally near the entrance with a sign marked Rally Office. You may be given a welcome note with information about the event and be directed to a pitch where you should position the driver side front corner of your caravan/motorhome as close as possible to the marker peg.

For caravanners, please park your car on the offside of your caravan parallel to it. Your Marshal will indicate where to obtain fresh water and where the elsan disposal point is located.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

The event may include varied social activities during the daytime or evening, such as games, quizzes, competitions, communal barbeques for young and old alike, or quiet evenings with background music to relax and chat with other ralliers. It may also include hired entertainment and/or catered dinning at certain 'special' events. All these events are generally great fun and entirely optional so you should never feel obliged to participate in anything you're not comfortable with.

FLAG POLE

This usually takes place on the last day of the event and is a chance for everyone on the event field to gather together with a cup of tea or coffee. The results of any competitions are announced, new ralliers and visitors are welcomed and Event Marshals and helpers are thanked for their efforts in making the event possible. Forthcoming events are announced along with any other Centre news. The hope is that we all have a safe journey home and leave looking forward to the next one!

WHAT WILL I NEED

To go to an event you will need your own toilet facility, the means to collect your own fresh water and a waste water container to collect your 'grey' waste water.

RULES FOR COMPETITIONS

Richard Strong Challenge Cup: Is to be awarded for the Brain of South London.

Stanley Meyer Cup: To be presented to the person attending the most South London Events in the year. (AGM to Nominations).

Alfie Piper Rose Bowl: Up to three 7in x 5in colour prints may be entered and the theme for 2026 is 'Nature on the Rally Field'.

Competition to be judged at the Nominations Event.

Leatherdale Cup: The Ladies of the Committee decide each year the subject of the competition.

Parker Shield: For the male South London Member returning the fastest time in the reversing competition at the National Event or Southern Centres Event.

Ladies Reversing Cup: For the female South London Member returning the fastest time in the reversing competition at the National Event or Southern Centres Event.

Shepherd Cup: The committee will decide the person, who on merit, deserves to be presented with the trophy.

Ron Pearce Cup: The cup is awarded to the member towing their caravan or driving their motorhome the greatest number of miles within the year in the British Isles.

Mileage to begin when leaving Nominations Event and to finish at the arrival of Nominations Event of the following year.

You can claim for all miles to and from South London events attended and 50% of the mileage to and from non-South London events (i.e. 1000 miles travelled with SLC claim all = 1000 or 1000 miles travelled for non SLC events claim half = 500).

50% of the total miles claimed must be for attending South London Events.

Claims to be handed to the Centre Secretary before or at the Nominations Event or by post to be received by 11.00am on the date of the Nominations Event.

Bill Marshall Fishing Cup: To be awarded to the adult male winner of the Centre's fishing competition.

French Family Ladies Fishing Shield: To be awarded to the adult female winner of the Centre's fishing competition.

John Sands Shield: To be awarded to any member nominated for outstanding efforts or achievements during the year. All Nominations must be submitted by Nominations Event.

The Micky Branch Humour Trophy: to be awarded to the member who the majority of the membership feel has brought the most humour to the centre during the year.

The above competitions are open to all South London members, and registered family members, eighteen years of age and over and no proxy entries will be accepted

The junior cups are the Jim Braun for boys, and the Jim Braun for girls. The junior members decide each year the subject of the competitions.

The John Sands Shield is awarded to the Centre Member who the majority of the membership feel has given outstanding effort or achieved the most during the year.

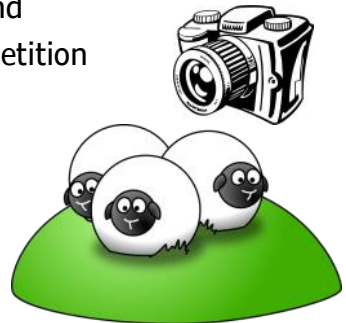

Important Notes Relating to the Annual General Meeting

Centre Registration

In accordance with Centre Rules (Version 25 October 2024) Item 3.1

A Club (CAMC) member may register, in the format prescribed, with not more than one Centre on joining the Club and on an annual basis at the time of Club membership renewal. It does not necessarily have to be the Centre covering the area in which they reside. (Don't forget to register every year it's not automatic)

Registration with a Centre will entitle a registered member to be informed of that Centre's activities.

A joint or family member may only register with the Centre with which the corresponding full member is registered.

Voting & Speaking Entitlement

In accordance with Centre Rules (Version 25 October 2024) Item 6.6

Not less than 21 clear days Notice of AGM's shall be given to each member who has registered in accordance with Centre Registration details above.

Only those members who have registered with the Centre shall be entitled to receive Notice of, or speak or vote at, such Meeting, and shall be eligible for election to the Committee at such Meeting.

The Notice of the AGM shall state the date, time and place of the Meeting and the principle business to be transacted, and shall include a copy of Rule 6.4. Items that materially affect Centre activities added subsequently to the Agenda shall be notified to members accordingly.

BOOKINGS.

Please send completed Rally Forms, which must be accompanied by the full remittance, to the Event Marshal by the date stated on the event form. Cheques are not banked until immediately prior to the rally/event at the earliest, unless otherwise advised by the Event Marshal. If you have been unable to book within the time requested you should make contact with the Event Marshal as you could possibly be welcomed provided there is a pitch available. Event plaques are only available to members who attend the rally with their own caravan/motorhome and only if they are being issued for that particular rally.

ARRIVAL AND SITING

Event opening/start times will be stated on the Event Form. Please do **not** arrive earlier than this time, later than 9.00 pm in the evening or earlier than 10.00 on a morning without prior arrangement with the Event Marshal. Caravans/motorhomes must be sited as directed by the Event Marshal. Generally, the Centre discourages saving of pitches, although this is entirely at the discretion of the Event Marshal. The towing vehicle should be parked on the off side of the sited caravan, unless otherwise directed.

N.B. On Rallies with hard standing, vans will be sited with safety in mind but may be closer.

EVENT CONDUCT

The use of an event site is a privilege, it is your responsibility to see that this privilege is not abused. Please therefore, observe the Caravan Code and uphold the good name of the Caravan & Motorhome Club and of the South London Centre.

All event-goers are expected to observe the rules of the Caravan & Motorhome Club and South London Centre, which are intended to consider the best interest and wellbeing of all members. The Rally Marshal concerned will settle any matters arising, and their decisions will be final. No advertising for commercial gain is generally allowed on the rally field.

Please ensure that only essential caravan equipment is visible outside the caravan and if, in an emergency, washing has to be dried outside please avoid it being an eyesore.

DRIVING AND SAFETY

RESTRICT YOUR SPEED TO 5MPH (WALKING PACE) AT ALL TIMES ON THE EVENT FIELD. Club insurance does not permit learner drivers on the event field. Only drivers with a full current driving license, insurance and road fund tax (when applicable) are permitted to drive on the event field. Drivers of additional vehicles and visitors should report to the Event Marshal for details of parking arrangements.

TENTS.

Trailer tents are permissible but must be sited separately and not interspersed with caravans and motorhomes. If the event field layout is restricted, trailer tents may continue a line of caravans/motorhomes. Pup tents are permissible on the rally field, but you must report your intention to the Event Marshal before erecting any form of tent. The Event Marshal's decision on acceptability is final.

SMOKING & VAPING

Please be aware that smoking and vaping is prohibited within all enclosed areas/buildings on site i.e. schools, halls or marquees.

PETS.

Dogs and other pets must be kept under control at all times and **ON A TETHERED LEAD**, when on site. The lead must not allow pets to reach adjacent caravans or awnings and vehicles or exceed a maximum of 2 metres in length whichever is the shortest. Pets likely to be aggressive and/or cause personal injury must be muzzled at all times. **ALL** pet owners are required to collect and remove fouling from the rally field promptly. No animal shall be allowed in buildings or marquees at any time in the interest of hygiene, health and safety of all occupants. The only exception to this rule is for guide dogs.

YELLOW FLAG.

If a yellow flag is flying on the flagpole, vehicle movement is restricted in order to minimise damage to the field. Members leaving the field will not be allowed back on with their vehicle, until conditions improve and the yellow flag is removed. The Event Marshal, whose judgement is final, will determine and impose any necessary traffic restrictions.

TOWING ASSISTANCE BY 4X4 VEHICLES IN ADVERSE CONDITIONS

1. The C&MC Public Liability Insurance does not provide cover for towing assistance therefore no responsibility is accepted by the Club.
2. The owner or driver of the tow vehicle should ensure they are covered under their own insurance and be aware that if a charge is made, it is not in breach of the insurance.
3. Members may be requested to contribute £1.00 per tow towards the driver's costs.
4. If an outfit requires separate tows i.e. car then caravan a contribution may be expected for each tow.
5. Members are advised to carry their own tow ropes and be familiar with the towing points on their vehicles.

NOISE AND GAMES.

Make sure that your children and grand children do not become a nuisance to other Centre Members and their property or their vehicles. Do not let them play around the caravans/motorhomes with balls, kites, bicycles, etc. Any damage incurred becomes the responsibility of the parents of the offending child. Consider your neighbours when using a radio, television or during a social activity. Please keep the volume down to a level that will not cause annoyance.

PLEASE keep all noise to a minimum after 11.00 pm. Generators are **NOT** to be used between

9.00pm and 10.00 am except in special circumstances and with the Event Marshal's approval.

SANITATION.

Your own toilet is essential. Toilet disposal points will be provided whenever possible. If you use a toilet tent it must be sited alongside your caravan i.e. close to a blank exterior wall.

Empty your toilet at the official disposal point only. Toilets must be sealed in transit to the disposal point and **NEVER** taken to a fresh drinking water point. Wastewater containers should not be allowed to overflow and be emptied at a point designated by the Event Marshal. Rubbish disposal facilities may be provided, otherwise all rubbish **MUST** be taken home with you. The site must be kept tidy and left clear of litter. A mains water supply will be available.

BARBECUES AND FIRE PRECAUTIONS.

Open fires are not allowed unless permitted by the Event Marshal and with the authority of the landowner. Approval for the use of barbecues, gas lights and gas heaters rests with the Event Marshal. Barbeques should be sited well away from outfits and raised off the ground to avoid fire risk. They should not cause inconvenience to others and it is recommended that outfits carry a BS approved fire extinguisher. Please take care **NOT** to light barbecues close to gas bottles, cars and awnings.

It is recommended that a red plastic bucket marked with the word **FIRE** is placed adjacent to the caravans 'A' frame and in front of a motorhome or wherever is most visible.

COMPLAINTS.

If a complaint is made to the Event Marshals or a member of the Committee, the right is reserved if necessary to expel any person and their property attending the rally. Justification will be notified and explained before this action is taken.

LOSS OR DAMAGE.

All persons attending rallies and social events do so entirely at their own risk. The Caravan & Motorhome Club and The South London Centre cannot accept responsibility for any persons or their property.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS.

Please refer to page 44 for The Centre's Booking Terms and Conditions or visit the SLC website.

POLITE REQUEST ON BEHALF OF EVENT MARSHALS

All our Event Marshals volunteer their free time to look after your interests. If you can't make it to the event or you will be late please phone the Marshal so he/she does not have to spend wasted time outside, sometimes in adverse weather conditions, when their time could be better used elsewhere.

HELPFUL THINGS TO REMEMBER

- When you send in an event Booking Form it must be accompanied by the full and correct payment due.
- Where cheques are agreed as a payment method, they should be made payable to the Caravan Club South London Centre.
- The preferred payment method can be made by BACS directly into the SLC bank account; S/C 20-25-42, Acc. No. 90240869. Please use the event venue and your surname as a payment reference.
- In principle, if you have not presented payment for the event you should not assume or consider you have made a booking.
- Please note that Members who are booked in and fail to attend an event will be subject to the SLC Booking Terms and Conditions shown below.
- Book early whenever possible as this helps the Marshals make appropriate arrangements for the correct number of attendees which ultimately is to everybody's benefit in helping the event run trouble free.

SLC RALLY BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) By making payment for any event you are accepting these T's and C's.
- 2) If you cancel an event due to ill-health or bereavement the Event Marshal will refer to the Centre Treasurer who will consider a full refund. This will be at the Centre Committee's discretion.
- 3) Any cancellation up to 2 weeks (14 days) prior to the event will be reimbursed at 50%, less any costs incurred.
- 4) Any cancellation up to 1 week (7 days) prior to the event will be at the Centre Committee's discretion and less any costs incurred.
- 5) Any rally cancelled less than 1 week (7 days) before the event will not be refunded (with the exception of 2 above).
- 6) If the Centre cancels the event all deposits/payments are refundable in full.
