Set in the heart of beautiful orchards on the outskirts of Faversham, Brogdale Farm is home to the Brogdale National Fruit Farm collection where extensive orchards grow over 400 varieties of apples here in the 'Garden of England'. Whitstable and Herne Bay are approx. 9 miles away, 25 mins by car.

Faversham is the local town just ½ mile away where there are many historical buildings to be found. Tours at the Shepherd & Neame brewery can be booked online and a stroll around 'Standard Quay', located at the bottom of the town, is well worth a visit to discover the history of the old port and to visit the various shops, cafés, eateries and antiques shops.

Take a stroll along the quay where 'Thames Sailing Barges' moor up, high water for the weekend is around 1pm so the creek should look very picturesque at this time. Alternatively explore the many pubs in and around Faversham town centre or if you're a fisherman 'The Willows Angling Centre' is close by in Teynham.

Daytime: The onsite restaurant is open for breakfast and the train around the orchards should be running.

Evening: The gazebos will be open and we will slip flag pole in at some point.

Directions **From the M2** exit the motorway at Junction 6 and head towards Faversham Town off the slip road. Continue across the new roundabout and turn left at the next traffic lights. Continue for approx. ¼ mile and turn left into Brogdale Road then turn left in ¼ mile into the venue. SLC signs will be positioned when nearing the venue entrance. **Please stop at the mini roundabout before entering the rally field and wait for a Marshal to direct you as the entrance needs to be approached in a certain way to avoid unnecessary manoeuvring.**
